
2 DAY PROGRAM - NOVEMBER CLASS NEWS

- Service Project- This holiday season, we would like to focus on the importance of kindness and helping others. One way to teach these concepts is to have our students take part in a service project. We invite all preschool friends and families to participate in our "Preschoolers Pack the Pantry" service project. Students, families, and/or friends may purchase food items, such as cereal, soup, rice, pasta, canned foods, or crackers, and bring them into the preschool. We will donate all food items to the Trona Valley Foundation Backpack Program, which helps families in need with meals and snacks. Look for more information to come home with important dates related to this project.

- Outside Safety Please remind your child to avoid walking or playing in the rocks or on the brick edging, as well as hanging or climbing on the trees. The instability of these areas can lead to injury of your child, or Trona Valley's landscaping. We also ask that students not walk around the building to the west side, where the concrete tables and benches are located. That is Trona Valley's break area, and a few of the concrete benches are broken and unstable. Also, stairs and walkways can always be slick this time of year, so remember to use caution while walking to or from the building, and in the parking lot.
