If you decided you would like to meet with teachers to review results, expect to receive a schedule with assigned meeting times by Friday, March 6th.
- **Kindergarten Readiness** – Please work at home to help prepare your child for kindergarten. Help them write their name, recognize letters and numbers, and remember that you can never read too much to a child. The preschool works on all these skills through a variety of methods at school, but practice at home will further encourage them. Try not to overdo it, as children develop at different times. Some children will be more ready than others. If there is anything we can help with at school, please bring it to our attention.
